



Tamkeen Program Withdrawal Process

The **Tamkeen Upskilling and Employability Program** is designed to support learners in developing employability skills, gaining certifications, and accessing career opportunities. Withdrawal from the program is strongly discouraged and permitted only through a structured process.

The following process applies to all learners who wish to withdraw from the program:

Step 1: Mandatory Reflection Period

- Learners must wait a minimum of 48 hours after their initial withdrawal request before it is processed.
- During this period, learners must complete a Withdrawal Request Form, which includes:
 - 1. **Reason for Withdrawal** (e.g., lack of time, financial issues, motivation concerns, coursework difficulty).
 - 2. **Alternative Support Options Explored** (e.g., tutoring, flexible scheduling, mentorship).
 - Impact Acknowledgment Statement, where learners confirm that they
 understand they will no longer have access to program benefits such as
 certification, career support, job placement assistance, and networking
 opportunities.

Step 2: One-on-One Counseling Session

- All learners requesting withdrawal must attend a withdrawal counseling session with a career coach or program advisor.
- The session will cover:
 - Possible **solutions** to the learner's challenges (e.g., flexible deadlines, mental health resources, tutoring).
 - Long-term impact of withdrawing, including potential loss of career-building opportunities.
 - Alternative pathways, such as switching to a different learning track or taking a temporary leave of absence instead of a full withdrawal.

Step 3: Exit & Appeals Process

A. Standard Conditional Exit

- If a learner insists on withdrawing after the counseling session, they must submit a formal withdrawal request in writing via [ahmed@localizedlearning.com].
- The request must include:
 - 1. A written **commitment statement** acknowledging the impact of withdrawal on career prospects and future Tamkeen eligibility.
 - 2. A confirmation that they understand that we will be sharing their withdrawal request with Tamkeen,

Step 4: Finalization of Withdrawal & Consequences

- If a learner withdraws without completing this process, they may face:
 - Notification to the Ministry of Labour,
 - Loss of all program benefits, including career services, certifications, and networking opportunities.
- If a **temporary deferral** is granted instead of a full withdrawal, the learner may have the option to **rejoin a later cohort**, subject to availability.

Summary of the Combined Withdrawal Process

Step	Action	Purpose	Outcome
Step 1	Mandatory 48-hour reflection period & Withdrawal Form	Encourages reconsideration and explores support options	Learner re-engages or moves to Step 2
Step 2	One-on-One Counseling Session	Helps address learner challenges & offers alternatives	Learner remains in the program, defers, or moves to Step 3
Step 3	Standard Withdrawal Request	Ensures the learner formally acknowledges the impact	Conditional withdrawal with restrictions
Step 4	Final Exit Process	Ensures proper documentation and enforcement of consequences if any	Learner exits or remains based on decision
